# Don't Stop Praying

**Prayer!** One of the most essential components of a believers life, yet one of the most commonly neglected--that is until a trial comes that forces us to our knees in hopes that God will deliver us. Sure, that is one advantage of prayer, but God's design for prayer goes far deeper and blesses more abundantly than that.

**Prayer is a lifestyle...**Not one day of a believer's life should go by without prayer. Actually the Lord Jesus teaches in Luke 18:1 that not one moment should pass devoid of prayer, saying men ought always to pray and not to faint. What is the significance of praying with such consistency you ask? Consistent power!

**Prayer of Agreement...**When two or three touch and agree, there is POWER! The more we have in agreement, the faster we get results. The church can't go anywhere if everyone is pulling in different directions.

**Prayer of Praise and Thanksgiving...**This is our expression of confidence and gratitude to God. Always know that God is on your side, giving Him praise through the good and bad. Meditate on Hebrews 13:15. God LOVES to hear from us, but not only in the times of trial and testing. He loves to hear our praise and thanksgiving as well.

**Prayer of Intercession...**Binding up, loosing and confessing! Never stop interceding on behalf of others. We have the power to cast down and rebuke the enemy. God wants us to stand in the gap for those who need prayer. He is always on time and He will come through.

**Prayer of Commitment...** In 1Peter 5:7, it is commanded of us to cast all our cares upon HIM. We know that all things will work together for our good, if we turn our problems over to him. Some things are just too much for us to handle. We must petition God and He WILL work it out.

**Prayer of Consecration...**Through prayer, we must yield our minds and spirit to God. It is important to give God ALL of who we are and not just bits and pieces. Rebuke, claim, declare, and decree, knowing that God hears and is ready to answer every request in line with his Word. There is no need to worry because Prayer is power. So whatever you do, **don't stop praying.**
